English

In English, we will work on our independent writing skills. Our fiction unit will be 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. We will describe characters and retell our own narrative. Then, we will write seaside poems and link recounts to our History unit.

Science

This half term, we will consolidate what we have learnt about animals and their habitats and how they have changed since winter. We will learn about what animals eat, food chains and how animals are suited to their habitats.

History

In History, we will learn about our locality and focus on Lord Ashton. We will learn about the impact he has had on Lancaster and how it changed over time.

Maths

In Maths, we will consolidate our knowledge of 2 and 3D shapes and then work on our calculations. We will add, subtract, divide and multiply numbers and apply these skills to real life contexts. Lastly, we will look into different types of graphs to collect and represent data.

Computing

In Computing, we will work on our programming skills and will learn how to use ScratchJr. We will make simple programmes and debug any that are not working.

DT

In DT, we will build our own structures and experiment with different materials. Our goal is to build a sturdy house using different 3D nets.

P.E

This half term we will work on our fundamental movement skills again, ready for Sports' Day. We will show great sportsmanship and give it our best!

PSHE

This half term will see us look at different types of medication and how to stay safe around them. We will learn where they come from and how they help us get better.

Music

We will consolidate our music skills this half term and begin to compose our own music. This will include finding the pulse of a song, experimenting with instruments and learning to play the recorder.
