

Spring 1: Learning in Year 2



English

In English we will be looking at Traditional tales with a twist, like Red Riding Hood, Goldilocks and the Three Little Pigs.

We will then begin looking at description texts - linking to our Geography topic, using descriptive language.

Maths

We will be looking at capacity, volume and time. Moving onto recapping place value from Autumn 1 and addition and subtraction.

From there we will be focussing on Money, mass, volume and capacity. We will then begin looking at Multiplication and Division - focussing on arrays and multiplication facts.

Science

In science we will be looking at humans, their offspring and their needs.

We will think about basic human needs and how offspring develop throughout their lives. Our focus scientists are Mary Seacole and Alexander Fleming!

Music

This half term we will be following Charanga - looking at 'I wanna play in a band'!
