

Spring 2: Learning in Year 2



English

We begin this term by looking at Recounts, Fact files, and letters!

We will be recounting our trip to the Pantomime before Christmas, creating a fact file about the butterfly life cycle, and then writing a letter as a soldier in the Crimea war about Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole!

Maths

We have started looking at Maths Mastery! We will be looking at multiplication, division and recapping place value with addition and subtraction! We will be using more concrete materials to manipulate the work!

Science

This half term, we will look at different life cycles of different animals; butterflies, frogs and chicks!

We will be looking at what is similar, different and research any questions we will have through investigations and independent research!

P.E

We are looking at Dance! We will be looking at moving to a rhythm and beat. We will also be looking at how to move from one position to another safely!

We will be looking at how they both created a
name for themselves, how they funded their own
progress and how they managed to stay so

Our RE this half term is all about the Easter story! We will be looking at the Last supper, the meaning of Good Friday, what Jesus did with his apostles and disciples, the crucifixion and then Jesus's resurrection! We will be looking at how these events are celebrated around the world!

Computing

Our PSHE unit this half term is all about the differences between boys and girls. We will be looking at how Male and Female animals are visually different (Sheep and ram - a ram has horns) and matching the parent to their offspring. This will cross over with our science unit!
